1. New University Libraries ILS (Integrated Library System)

- Lea Briggs, Migration Project Management Librarian, University Libraries

The library's ILS System (Integrated Library system) is the heart and lungs of the library – replacing it is like performing an operation on a person. Migration initiative is on track for July 28 implementation date – at that time all of the main campus libraries will switch over to the new system. Branch libraries will go live in Nov/Dec. There will be a beta link to the new system available on the library website on June 30. Course reserves system will stay the same for the present.

Lea will be sending a lot of notices to university listservs during summer. Moira Gerety and Debby Knotts recommended Lea come to IT Agents meeting and give presentation. Moira and Elisha Allen recommended local caching - Lea should talk to IT about possible caching to improve system performance.

- Stephen Burd, UNM Provost's Academic Technology Liaison
 - In late March the IATF narrowed RFP finalists down to 3 Will email summary of presentations today
 - One vendor parent co. went bankrupt removes them from competition
 - 2 real finalists left cadillac and economy version products Explorance Blue & EvaluationKit -100K vs. 30K
 - Will provide demo Sandbox for both finalists over the summer so students and faculty can test.
 - If all goes well, we'll have a small pilot this fall, a large pilot in the Spring, implementation of selected system in Spring 2015.
 - Andrew Yoder wants to get NMEL and other groups together to integrate surveys requested of students each semester. Need to standardize and make university requirements to use new system - centralize high level questions
