Colleagues,

As you know, Dr. Glenabah Martinez and I've been co-chairing the UNM Provost Diversity Council Curriculum Committee and we are in the process of submitting a Form C proposal to introduce a 3 credit "U.S. & Global Diversity & Inclusion (USGDI)" requirement at the undergraduate level (100-400 level courses). We need your help. Since you or your departmental colleagues teach courses that address diversity & inclusion in the U.S. or global context (e.g., race, gender, disability, sexual orientation, class, religion). The main criteria is that the course be primarily focused on diversity and inclusion (50% content) in any of the aforementioned areas. Please see attached proposal for more details on the proposal and student learning outcomes. If you do have courses that fulfill these learning outcomes please forward syllabi materials to Swechha Singh (swechha@hotmail.com). It is important to note that while the proposal is for an undergraduate requirement, we are also working on a final report for the Diversity Council that will include several recommendations including one that would develop a graduate level certificate on "Diversity, Equity and Inclusion" in the future. Also, upper level undergraduates are able to enroll in graduate level courses with permission of the instructor. We are therefore creating a list of both graduate and undergraduate level courses and we welcome all your syllabi.

Thank you for your help! We plan to submit this Form C proposal to the undergraduate committee of the Faculty Senate by mid-November. Once we have compiled the list of all courses that would meet this requirement, we will need to compile a matrix that lists the capacity in terms of the student caps for each of these courses as well as how often they are taught so if you have this information it would be helpful too. All of this will be included as appendixes for with the Form C proposal. We would also love any feedback you may have on the proposal and invite you to circulate it among your colleagues for feedback. We have been meeting with all the Deans have have received generous feedback and support. Our next meeting of the Curriculum Committee is Mon. Nov. 5th. in SSCI 1061 (Social Sciences Bldg, Sociology Department Commons), 1-2:30pm. Everyone is welcome!
