

**Faculty Senate Curriculum Committee

C. Library has *CollegeSource* database subscription that is set to expire (only subscribed through 2011). This database makes copies of around-the-world-catalogs available for searching. It is believed that the Degree Audit staff can access *CollegeSource* without the Librarian subscription, which, if true, would not require the \$8000 subscription fee for college-wide use.

D. There are some programs, (e.g. Russian B.A., Russian Studies, Latin American Studies), that are considering a form of consolidation. White papers will need to be defended and then a decision to keep separate or not will be made.
