Re: Changing the name of the Department of Educational Specialties to the Department of Special Education

The justification for this request relates to changes to the programs within the existing Educational Specialties department. At one time the department of Educational Specialties housed three academic programs. Two of these programs have been moved out of the department during the past few years. The MSET program was moved several years ago to the department of Teacher Education, Educational Leadership & Policy (TEELP); the Art Education program was moved to the College of Fine Arts effective in the coming academic year.

There is no longer any program in the department other than the Special Education Program, which is a large and complex academic program comprising undergraduate and graduate degrees, specialized transcripted certificates, NM licensure in three areas, and coursework and field experience required for national certification in Applied Behavior Analysis approved by the Behavior Analyst Certification Board

The following degrees and certificates are included in Special Education: BSED Dual License; undergraduate SPCD minor; MA in Special Education (Concentration I and Concentration II); transcripted graduate certificate in Applied Behavior Analysis; transcripted graduate certificate in Autism Spectrum Disorder; transcripted graduate certificate in Educational Diagnosis; EdS in SPCD; and a doctorate (PhD) in Special Education.
