The Music Education Minor was just changed last year, and the history requirement choice of either MUS 361 or MUS 362 was made without realizing that the prerequisite (MUS 152/152L) for those courses is not part of the requirements for the Music Education Minor. We are therefore changing the history requirement to MUS 371 (Music History for Non-Majors), which does not require a prerequisite. Also, since MUS 361 and 362 comprise a two-semester overview, the degree plan as currently stated requires the student to learn only half of the historical picture; MUS 371 covers the entire historical range from medieval to present in one semester, and while the material is necessarily covered in less depth, it is felt that the more important consideration is that the student learn something about all the periods of music history.
