1. Greetings and welcome to committee members and guests.

2. Review of meeting minutes from 12/3/2019

- Dixon proposed motion to accept minutes into the record. Laws seconded. Vote of members, passed unanimously.

2. UNM LMS Updates and Discussion

- Scenarios, RFP Questions & Narrative – Stephanie Spong (CDL) introduced process. Jenn Laws added comments into scenarios. Scenarios were displayed and reviewed by entire group in attendance.
 - Concerns raised:
 - Course copying – design course should look the way it will to students
 - Debby Knotts (Extended Learning) mentioned this has been a common request
 - GradeBook – doesn't start at 0 (zero points) reflects A+ even if no grades have been entered
 - Assignments
 - Academic integrity - clarification to any additional hardware
 - Adaptive release – add clear question for vendors
 - Multiple due dates – especially for discussion boards
 - Creation and editing – musical and logical expressions
 - Accessibility – BlackBoard Ally: can make Word doc accessible which will make pdf accessible
 - Group Work – need for peer grading option to allow anonymous grading of de-identified work
 - Multiple sections – how to address integrity issues across all sections
 - Allow for different grouping/grading options between sections

- Experiences levels
 - Range of users
 - What kind of support to expect
 - LMS transition/migration
 - Proof of concept: Include a test to migrate 5 actual courses
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- RFP scoring begins after March 10
 - Tentative faculty feedback window: April 14 – May 1
