The Nutrition Program would like to change the required Biochemistry course from Intensive Introductory Biochemistry I BIOC 446 (4 credit hours) to Introductory Biochemistry I (BIOC 423 3 credit hours) in the undergraduate Nutrition Program curriculum. BIOC 423 more appropriately reflects the needs of the nutrition majors in terms of fundamentals of biochemical processes related to nutrient metabolism. In addition, the Nutrition Program would like to integrate NUTR 322 (Management in Dietetics II) into NUTR 321 (Management in Dietetics I). NUTR 322 is intended to apply basic information and management theories (budgeting, marketing, menu design, procurement, production) presented in NUTR 321. In reviewing syllabi for NUTR 321 and 322, Nutrition Program faculty found significant overlap. A new syllabus was developed, condensing NUTR 322 and 321 into one 3-credit hour "Management in Dietetics" (NUTR 321) course. The proposed change will not affect other Departments or Programs since both courses are restricted to students admitted to the B.S. or minor in Nutrition Programs and these courses are not required for any other major or minor on campus. Associated Forms have been submitted to delete NUTR 322 and rename NUTR 321 to "Management in Dietetics" (Form A4268).
