The Latin American Studies and Nursing units request that their shared dual degree (MALAS/MSN) program be eliminated. Curriculum changes, primarily on the MSN side, have made it virtually impossible to sustain the dual degree. Many nursing students now pursue much of their coursework online, yet the LAS curriculum continues to be delivered in a traditional, on-campus format. Neither program has been accepting applications for several years, and the chairs/directors have spoken on various occasions about whether or not the dual degree can be tweaked to accommodate the curriculum changes. These discussions, along with broader discussions with involved faculty, have resulted in a mutual decision to eliminate the dual degree.
