As a result of a review of the curriculum by the program faculty and student comments, it was decided to combine the content of Admin/Sup 1 and 2 as well as Psych/soc/cultural competence 1 and 2. This will allow the various faculty members to write cases together to incorporate the most important elements needed for each course. PT 680 Admin Sup will combine the two one-credit courses into one two-credit course. PT 622 Psych/Soc/Cultural Competence will combine the current one and two credit courses into one three-credit course.

Effect: Deletion of the two courses, PT623 and PT681 does not affect the PT program or its budget, as the total credits do not change. This change does not affect the branch campuses.
