<p>Proposed Concentration Justification</p> <p>**REG OFF**- Reorganized the gen ed section so that it contains only the 31 required credits and is labeled with the HED mandated gen ed section titles. Courses that were taken out of this section were put into a new section for concentration requirements.</p> <p>We are adding one additional graduation requirement: Successful completion of the Educator Preparation Program Portfolio is required within the Early Childhood Multicultural Education concentration. This change is being requested to align our licensure program with the State of New Mexico licensure requirement that all licensure candidates complete a portfolio.</p> <p>We have not changed the number of credits or classes required for this concentration. All early childhood Associate and Bachelor degree programs across the state of New Mexico, in order to maintain articulation across programs, must follow the syllabi templates as their basic framework for developing specific courses. Each faculty member may revise any syllabus to meet his/her own needs as long as there is no change in the following: Course Title, Course Credits, and Course Description.</p> <p>The concentration name change request addresses the "Early Childhood Multicultural Education Licensure Pre-K to Grade 3" concentration of the Bachelor of Science degree in Family and Child Studies. The request is that we delete the word "Pre-K" from the concentration title and insert the words "Age 3." The program requests this title change to represent better the broad</p>

diversity of early childhood programs available in New Mexico. Students graduating from this concentration teach in various early childhood settings beyond New Mexico Pre-K programs.
