Program Description

The interdisciplinary graduate minor in Global & National Security Policy (GM-GNSP) is intended to be a low barrier for current UNM graduate students of other disciplines to add GLNS substance to their graduate degrees. The graduates will get grounding in policy analysis and writing skills in the core course, then choose electives for which substantive global or national security content courses to which they can apply their policy analysis skills. Thus, students can sample GLNS courses or concentrate in a thematic area of GLNS courses. Graduates will receive a transcribable credit and decide if they wish to stay and complete the entire Professional Master of Science coursework. This graduate minor is ideal for students of UNM's Master of Public Policy or Political Science Master/PhD degrees to signal to future employers their thematic concentration in global and national security policy in addition to their grounding in Public Policy or Political Science. It is also ideal for graduate students in STEM fields, especially engineering or cybersecurity, who wish to supplement their technical education with coursework in national security technology policy.
