Content has been taken from PT 507, 508, 544, 610 and PT 640 to create the following new courses: PT 510, Management of Integumentary Dysfunction; PT 506, Orthopaedic Treatment: PT 545, Differential Diagnosis; PT 546, Pharmacology in PT. PT 694 replaces the former course PT 690 which was inadvertently deleted by the Program. The total number of program credits increases by 2 to 122 credits.

Form C Justification

The course revisions represent reorganization of material covered in current courses but no new content. Content has been taken from current courses to create the following new courses: PT 510, Management of Integumentary Dysfunction; PT 506, Orthopaedic Treatment; PT 545, Differential Diagnosis; and PT 546, Pharmacology in PT. The creation of these new courses will reinforce the importance of the content to the students, because they will now be issued separate grades for the respective content. Additionally, the changes will make it more apparent to the Commission on Accreditation in Physical Therapy Education that our curriculum addresses all required areas.

Because the content is already covered by current faculty there will be no impact on long range program planning, nor are budgetary adjustments required. PT 510 will be taught by a new faculty hire who fills a vacated faculty position. This individual was directed to teach this course, covering content previously taught by adjunct faculty. There are no faculty workload implications.
