2	The Meeting & Issues (Room 101, Scholes Hall)	<ul> <li>The meeting began with a follow up presentation by Andrew Cullen, Budget Office, on UNM's budget.</li> <li>Points from Andrew Cullen's presentation:         <ul> <li>The state cut the main campus budget by \$4.5 million. The total amount of the cut for UNM is \$7.9 million, and this includes the Health Sciences Center (HSC), Research and Public Service Projects and the branch campuses;</li> <li>Referring to an article that appeared in a recent issue of the Albuquerque Journal, reporting on money the state wants to take from HSC and apply to Medicaid, Andrew reported that eventually the state of New Mexico will have to find a way to fund Medicaid. This will be accomplished by either raising taxes and making cuts to other state budgets;</li> <li>Andrew also reported that UNM is in danger of more deep cuts next year;</li> <li>A discussion followed on ideas for how the university can become less dependent on state funding in the years ahead;</li> </ul> </li> <li>The UNM Faculty Survey Results (<i>Ann Brooks &amp; Janie Chermak</i>):         <ul> <li>1,954 faculty invited to participate;</li> <li>524 responded (26.8%);</li> <li>386 completed the survey (19.8%);</li> <li>Individual question responses between 19.2% - 21.3%;</li> <li>Female respondents 51/5%;</li> <li>The majority of respondents have worked at UNM ten years, or less;</li> <li>A discussion followed addressing the results of specific survey question responses;</li> <li>At this time the survey results will not be made public due to a promise made to the Committee on Governance.
