## Topics

1. Review of meeting minutes from 3/26/2020
  - Dixon proposed motion to accept minutes as amended into the record. Osinski seconded. Vote of members, 6 in favor, 0 opposed, 1 abstain.
2. Review of meeting minutes from 4/30/2020
  - Laws proposed motion to accept minutes into the record. Osinski seconded. Vote of members, 7 in favor, 0 opposed, 0 abstain.
3. IT/AT/CDL updates
  - Jon Bocock (IT/AT) reported that data center planned outage/updates successful.
  - Replacement for BlackBoard Collaborate (phased out as of December 2020)
    - BlackBoard had promised Collaborate Ultra would resolve student privacy issues by mid-Spring but missed that deadline. When promised deadlines missed, decision was made not to use.
    - Alternative options will be Kaltura and Zoom
  - Respondus Lock-Down Browser (proctoring tool) – purchased through July 2021
    - 16 summer sections – Nursing program
    - Remaining concerns about student access. A few students borrowed loaner laptops to take quizzes through Respondus. Proctoring tool available in computers labs on campus.
  - LMS RFP – restarting work after break due to COVID-19.

- Duane Arruti (IT/AT) reported that campus classrooms were being identified and converted for hybrid instruction in Fall 2020. Two levels of conversion: minimum and premium. Trying to convert as many classrooms as possible. If not all ready by Fall, will be for Spring 2021. Identified funding for 100 classrooms \$5000 installation price tag. Also dependent on external resources such as cameras and microphones, also subcontractor availability for installation.
  - Executive Team from Provost's Office to determine priorities for back to campus phase-in
  - Scheduling no longer concerned with maximizing classroom space – planning larger spaces for smaller number of students
- 4. Space(s) for faculty information exchange – with more people teaching online, would it be helpful to have a space for faculty to share ideas/recommendations on best [personal] purchases of hardware, software, communication, etc.?
  - Center for Teaching & Learning offers support for instructors and faculty
  - Maybe a discussion board could be created specifically for information exchange
    - MS Teams might be a good option
  - IT/AT reps asked that these hardware/software needs also be shared with College IT Officers
- 5. Plans for Summer training for faculty who teach at a distance
  - Stephanie Spong (CDL) said that these would not be mandatory
- 6. Upcoming meetings: 1pm to 2pm on June 25<sup>th</sup> and July 23<sup>rd</sup>; Zoom access/Meeting ID is recurring
