This individual is interested in furthering his/her professional growth by completing a Master's degree that incorporates advanced study of specific areas of education. The M.A. in Education is designed to be a journey in personal and professional growth. In their program of studies, students engage in purposeful work in each of four core areas: 1) social justice, diversity and transformational practices; 2) instructional strategies; 3) curriculum; 4) and research. The goal is that students improve their teaching and their thinking about the teaching process, resulting in greater depth of meaning for their students. NOTE: Changes in state requirements or state reform initiatives in education may require periodic revisions of the curriculum and admissions process.
